**Adult Content Policies:**

Demonstration events that include sexual content are banned from Pagan Pride celebrations, including but not limited to workshops on techniques and sexually themed items for sale. Discussion events are acceptable. However be mindful that media may be present and hopefully will help to meet our goal of public acceptance. We embrace education and informative events on all topics of interest to Pagans, as long as they are handled responsibly. Keep in mind we strive to be a family friendly event.

**Policy on Teenage Participation:**

We believe in encouraging pride in Pagans of all ages. However, the rights of minors are limited by parental choice. No minor shall participate in the planning, vending or presentation of workshops or rituals here at Eastern Mass Pagan Pride Day, without prior written from the minor's parent(s) or legal guardian(s). Since our event is held in a public place, we do not have the right to, nor would want to, prohibit the attendance of anyone at our event to anyone due to their age. Though they may not plan or present without written consent, minors are welcome to attend.

Workshop Guidelines

Workshop topics should focus on earth-honoring religious or cultural traditions, sustainable living, health and healing, or other related mind, body, or spirit topics. Each workshop will be 30-45 minutes long. If you need more time and would like to extend the workshop to span more than one time block, please indicate on the application how much extra time you would anticipate using. If we can accommodate your request, we will.

All workshop proposals will be considered by subject, content, and other relevant criteria. Due to time and space constraints, it is possible that not all proposals will be accepted. The Workshop Coordinator will contact you with further details. Since we'll be outdoors, there will not be an electrical power supply, and therefore no available AV equipment.

Workshops can include any combination of presentation styles: speaking, handouts, guided discussion, Q & A, etc. (IF you are using handouts or visual aids, please bring them with you.) If you have questions about workshop presentation styles please contact the Workshop Coordinator.

Workshops will be scheduled throughout the duration of the event and no time can be guaranteed.

\*Please don't discuss politics or bash other religions during your workshop.

\*Presenters, as this is a charity event we request that you donate your time.

However you are welcome to sell items that relate to your presentation during your workshop time.
